Since completing studies at Yeshiva College (B.A., 1964) and Columbia University (M.A. 1965, Ph.D., 1970), **Rabbi David Berger** has pursued research in the history of medieval Jewry, Jewish-Christian relations, messianic ideas and movements, the intellectual history of the Jews, and contemporary Orthodox Judaism. He is the author of *The Rebbe, the Messiah, and the Scandal of Orthodox Indifference* (London and Portland, Oregon: Littman Library of Jewish Civilization, 2001) and numerous other books and articles. Prof. Berger is the immediate past President of the Association for Jewish Studies, a member of the Executive Committee of the American Academy of Jewish Research, and Vice-Chair of the Academic Advisory Committee of the National Foundation for Jewish Culture.
